GIFT-GIVING AND GIFT-RECEIVING

It may seem an odd time of the year to bring this up, but I remember our friars' community Christmas party way back when I was a novice here at St. Gertrude Priory (1995–

1996). We all gathered together in the rec room and proceeded to open gifts from our Secret Santas among the brethren, as well as any gifts from our family members. I remember, at one point, our prior at the time, Father Bill Holt, was opening a gift from his brother. It was a box that contained a dress shirt. As he held up the shirt, a card fell out from it. Thinking it was a card from his brother, he opened it and began to read. At that point, he discovered it was a card addressed *to* his brother from his sister—dated to the previous year's Christmas!

The conclusion was inevitable: his brother didn't appreciate the shirt his sister had given him the year before, so this Christmas he decided to re-gift it to Father Holt. The whole community erupted in laughter when the truth became apparent. I can only imagine what the conversation was like next time Father Holt spoke to his brother on the phone!

In the secular world of Christmas gifts, such re-gifting is definitely a social faux pas. But in the world of our faith, not only is it *not* a faux pas, it is actually something commanded to us by God.

"As each one has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace. Whoever preaches, let it be with the words of God; whoever serves, let it be with the strength that God supplies, so that in all things God may be glorified through Jesus Christ, to whom belong glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen" (1Peter 4:10-11).

The first part of that Scripture passage is often paraphrased, "What you have received as gift, give as gift." Under my direction, our parish director of stewardship, Hope Ramundo, is designating this weekend as a special time of renewal of our parish Stewardship of Talent. It is a weekend where we are inviting every single parishioner to do a few things:

- 1. Spend some time truly **recognizing** the gifts, abilities, and talents that God has blessed you with.
- 2. Be intentional about thanking God for all of those gifts.
- 3. Seriously discern how God might be asking you, at this moment in your life to share those gifts with our parish and

wider community.

No matter how old or young, whether you are a cradle Catholic or a new convert, whether your faith is super strong or you are just dipping your toes into the world of Catholicism, you have been given gifts from God. And God is asking you to share those gifts.

If you are looking for where to start, consider stopping by our Parish Ministry Expo in the gym after the 8 a.m. or 10 a.m. Mass this weekend. If you can't attend that, reach out to Hope either by email at hramundo@stgertrude.org or by calling the main parish office number at (513) 561-5954 and asking to be put through to Hope. Believe me, you will not be "imposing" on her at all—quite the contrary! This is (literally) why we hired her: to help match up parishioners and their gifts with the needs and ministries of St. Gertrude Parish. So whether you have been at our parish forever or you are brand new and trying to "find your place" in our very big and busy parish, Hope is the person to get you connected.

"What you have received as gift, give as gift." Those words are addressed to you. I pray that, this weekend, you take those words to heart and make the decision to share your gifts with the rest of us. Our lives will all be richer as a result.

CHILDREN & YOUTH FAITH FORMATION

The shopping has begun (and maybe finished), schedules are being arranged, sports are underway, nerves or excitement levels are ramping up, plans for first day

pictures are somewhere in the back of mom's mind—it's back to school time. Here at St. Gertrude Parish, that means our children and youth Faith Formation programs are about to begin as well! Whether you're a seasoned veteran with your third or fourth child in Confirmation prep or a brand new family wondering what in the world a "CGS" is, this article is for you!

What Is Children & Youth Faith Formation at Our Parish? Who Is It For?

Faith Formation is a group of ministries from pre-K through 8th grade that focuses on assisting parents in forming their children in the faith, also known as catechesis. It includes:

- Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (Pre-K–Grade 6) A
 Montessori-influenced style of faith formation, using
 prepared environments, hands-on materials, and prayerful
 direction from trained adults.
- Sacramental Formation (Typically Grade 2) A parent-andchild experience of sacramental formation for those preparing for First Communion and First Reconciliation.
- Family Faith (Grades 3-6) A parent-and-child formation

- experience on Sundays that supports parents as the primary formers of their children's faith, connects parents, and shares the story of how God is forming a people to be his own.
- Confirmation Preparation (Typically Grades 7-8) A twoyear preparation ministry that mostly focuses on small group discussion and mentorship from adult and teen leaders to foster fruitful reception of Confirmation. Includes clear and relevant teaching about Confirmation and the Christian life.

All children and families of the parish are invited to participate in Faith Formation! For those also enrolled in other Catholic education (Catholic school, homeschooled), enrollment is not expected for participation in sacramental initiation.

Where Do I Start? / How Do I Learn More?

Is Anything Different This Year Compared to Last Year?

Yes! This year, we have more weekday CGS offerings and a new atrium in the Parish Center. We also changed our Confirmation Preparation meetings to weekly rather than twice a month.

WALKING WITH YOUNG PEOPLE IN IRELAND

A few years ago, I moved to Cincinnati and found myself surrounded by a strong Catholic community. Through the example

of incredible friends, I began to grow in my relationship with Christ. Their joy and love for God and others made me want that for myself—and I found I was called to share it with others, too. That calling is what led me to apply to serve with NET Ministries. This fall, I'll be heading to Ireland for a year of mission.

NET (National Evangelization Teams) sends young adults to minister to youth through retreats, parish outreach, and

discipleship. I learned about NET's efforts in Ireland through St. Gertrude Parish's youth minister, Shannon Loughrey. After a lot of prayer and conversations, I knew this was what God was calling me to do. What excites me most is the chance to walk with young people and be the kind of witness my friends were for me.

As a missionary, I'm responsible for raising a minimum of \$8,700, with my actual expenses during the year being \$19,000, which is what NET encourages us to raise.
