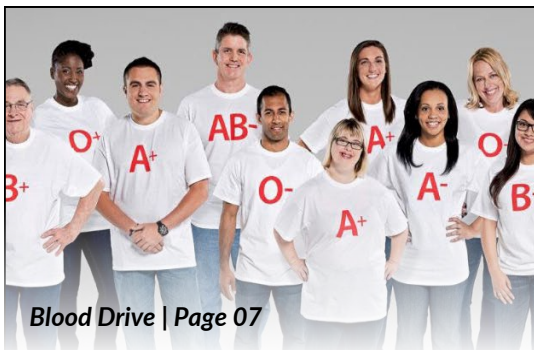

**ONE WEEK FROM TODAY:
OUR GREAT PARISH "PDA"**

Next Sunday, June 7, the Church will celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, often called *Corpus Christi*, Latin for "Body of Christ." Our

parish has a long tradition of celebrating this day with reverence and solemnity and, in recent years, a procession after Mass.

This year again, after the 10 a.m. Mass, we will be doing a full Eucharistic Procession from our church down Miami Avenue to the city municipal building at the corner of Miami Avenue and Euclid Avenue. The Madeira Police Department will have a police car leading the procession and officers blocking off Miami Avenue and the various cross streets along our path. After arriving in front of the municipal building, we will have Benediction with the Blessed Sacrament to conclude the procession. There will be busses waiting to take everyone back to the St. Gertrude Parish campus, where we will then have a big ice cream party in the gym to celebrate the feast.

Our wonderful altar servers, some of whom will be ringing bells to alert people along the route that we are coming, will lead the procession. Following them will be the flower girls—young girls of the parish who will be scattering flower petals on the road before the Blessed Sacrament. We will have an honor guard of the 4th Degree Knights of Columbus, followed by the thurifers, the priest carrying the monstrance, the other clergy, and then the congregation and the choir.

What I want to address with the rest of this letter is: Why? Why process all the way right through downtown Madeira?

The answer is simple: public witness. Our procession next Sunday will be a collective, public witness of our faith. You may have heard the abbreviation "PDA," standing for public display of affection. What we are doing is a different sort of PDA: **public display of adoration**. A witness to our belief in the True Presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. A witness to the fact that we owe Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament our true adoration. A witness to the fact that there are believers—many believers—right here in this community. A witness to the fact that Catholicism is not (as many would argue) dying, but right here in Madeira is very, very much alive and growing.

My hope is that, as we walk by the store fronts, restaurants, and cafes, people gawk at us. My hope is that they wonder who we are and what we are doing. My hope is that, even if they don't understand, they will nonetheless perceive something very important is happening. My hope is that our public proclamation of faith might rekindle a spark in fellow Catholics who have

drifted away from the faith. My hope is that our procession is the instrument by which God's grace will pierce the hearts of nonbelievers and make them think, *I'm not quite sure what that is . . . but I want to be a part of that.*

What we will do next week will arguably be the most important thing our parish does all year. I hope everyone joins me on Corpus Christi as we witness to the True Presence of Jesus Christ in our midst and to ask his blessings upon us and upon our community.

"On one occasion, God's presence pervaded my whole being, and my mind was mysteriously enlightened in respect to His Essence. He allowed me to understand His interior life. He is One, and One only, but in Three Persons; none of Them is either greater or smaller; there is no difference in either beauty or sanctity, for They are One... When One of the Three Persons communicates with a soul, by the power of that One will, it finds itself united with the Three Persons and is inundated in the happiness flowing from the Most Holy Trinity, the same happiness that nourishes the saints... In these moments, my soul experienced such great divine delights that I find this difficult to express."

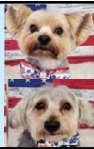



